- Official copy of NCCPA scores (if certified) – sent directly from NCCPA
- A one page typewritten narrative stating why you are interested in becoming an Emergency Medicine PA
- Application Fee of \$40.00 (Checks made payable to: AEMC Department of Emergency Medicine)
